The **AgroBioHeat** project would like to invite you to a workshop and field visits entitled "**Using Vineyard Prunings for Heat**".

Vineyards are cultivated in more than 3 million hectares in Europe. Every year, huge quantities of vineyard prunings are generated as part of the agronomic practices, but the vast majority of this quantity is not properly disposed and is burnt on the field. However, it is possible to bring value to this biomass resource by using it as a raw material for heat production. By joining this event, participants will have the opportunity to gain first-hand knowledge of how stakeholders in the Penedés wine region have managed to implement sustainable heat production for their municipality and businesses.
